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Traumatic injuries are the leading cause of death in people under the age of 40, a mortality rate third only to cancer and heart disease! But the lives of many severely injured patients can be saved with immediate treatment.

Critical, life-and-death decisions are made every day at Laniado Hospital's Emergency Department and Trauma Unit, which is only the emergency room serving the residents of Netanya and the environs. It diagnoses and provides initial treatment for over 70,000 people a year who arrive with severe injuries and illnesses, many of them life-threatening, that require immediate attention. About half of the people require hospitalization; the others are treated and sent home. Whether your emergency is minor or severe, you will always receive prompt and compassionate, world-class care!

The Emergency Department includes a triage unit for initial screening, a treatment room, a plaster room, rooms for ambulatory treatment, a 2-room x-ray unit, and an eye examination room. It has 13 ordinary care beds, a trauma bed, two orthopedic beds and three surgical beds.



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
